You are to draw three squares of 6" by 6" on one 18"x22" sheet of vellum paper. Distribute nicely the three squares on the sheet. Draw a grid of ½" by ½" on a fourth square on a separate sheet and use it as an under laying base to trace over it the other three squares. Subdivide the 6" squares into at least one of each (or more) of the following shapes: an L shape(s), a rectangle(s), a square(s). The sizes of these shapes are up to you but the minimum dimension should be 2" and all based on increments of the ½" module. Each of the three squares should have different subdivisions. Present all three squares for review.

**Part Two**

Cut up the shapes from the three squares. Make a collage with the shapes of each square by overlapping them and slightly shifting them away from each other to decompose the square shape they came from. Have these posted on a board. Present the three collages for review.

**Part Three**

Make three final collages by taking the square collages you made and reproduce the shapes in different materials. Make doubles of each of the shapes, of each of the squares in the same material. One of the squares should be in basswood, another in museum board and the third in opaque plexiglass. Assemble your compositions for presentation on a board. Present your final collages for review.
